

The Great Out-tours – Outdoor Learning Programme (OLP)

- Terms and Conditions -

1. If a pupil(s) does not attend an OLP session(s) due to illness or any other reason, the fixed GROUP SESSION FEE will still be levied.
2. Should any term time OLP session(s) BE CANCELLED BY THE CLIENT SCHOOL, due to school closure, resultant from extreme weather conditions, The Great Out-tours still levy the applicable session(s) fee(s).
3. Should any term time OLP session(s) BE POSTPONED by either THE CLIENT SCHOOL (whilst still operational) OR THE GREAT OUT-TOURS, due to adverse weather conditions, The Great Out-tours will liaise with the school staff to secure a replacement session run date. 📌 Where possible, The Great Out-tours will endeavour to uphold the running of any OLP session, and will liaise with THE CLIENT SCHOOL to seek an indoor activity area alternative. i.e. School hall.
4. Should any term time OLP session BE CANCELLED BY THE CLIENT SCHOOL, due to school closure, resultant from breakdown of school engineering systems i.e. Heating, water, electricity etc, The Great Out-tours still levy the applicable session(s) fee(s).
5. Should any term time OLP session BE CANCELLED BY THE CLIENT SCHOOL, due to school closure, resultant from teacher industrial strike action, The Great Out-tours still levy the applicable session(s) fee(s).
6. Should any term time OLP session(s) BE CANCELLED BY THE CLIENT SCHOOL, due to school closure, resultant from a local/nationwide pandemic, The Great Out-tours still levy the applicable session fee(s) affected.
7. If The Great Out-tours instructor team cannot deliver an OLP session, for reasons of staff sickness/injury, a replacement session date will be mutually agreed/run.
8. For each OLP session, pupils require wellington boots or waterproof footwear, clothing & rainwear suitable for outdoor activities, namely getting wet, cold, dirty, indelibly marked & potentially damaged. The Great Out-tours cannot accept responsibility for any damaged or indelibly marked clothing sustained at a school OLP session.

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9. The Great Out-tours will bill THE CLIENT SCHOOL at the end of each calendar month, for all OLP sessions run in the corresponding period.
10. Mid-programme cessation: At the inception of a CLIENT SCHOOL'S OLP, a detailed run date schedule is issued covering the work period specified/engaged. Mid programme cessation is not possible.

End of programme cessation: We request a full school term or 6 weeks' notice (whichever is greater), of a CLIENT SCHOOL'S intention not to renew their OLP for another work period/academic year.

11. The Great Out-tours strive to capture via photographs, the illuminating learning & fun that all children experience at OLP sessions.

Social media representation:

The Great Out-tours have dynamic educational social media presence on Facebook & Instagram, and display such aforementioned pictures within school specific club galleries. These photographs enable parents/carers/guardians, to see more about what their children have learnt on OLP sessions.

The Great Out-tours ensure that no children are named or "tagged" in social media posted photos.
